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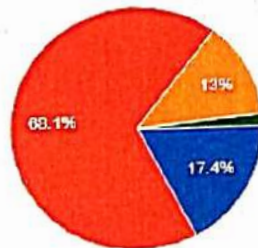

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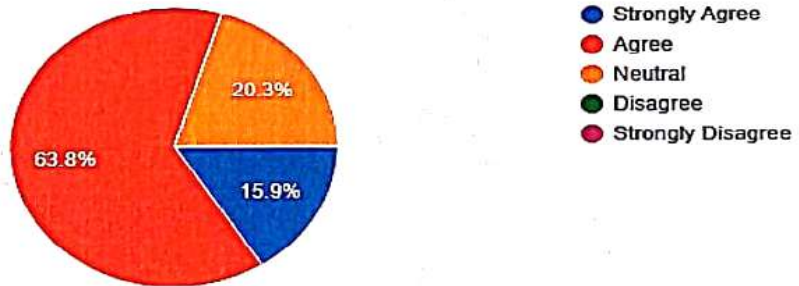

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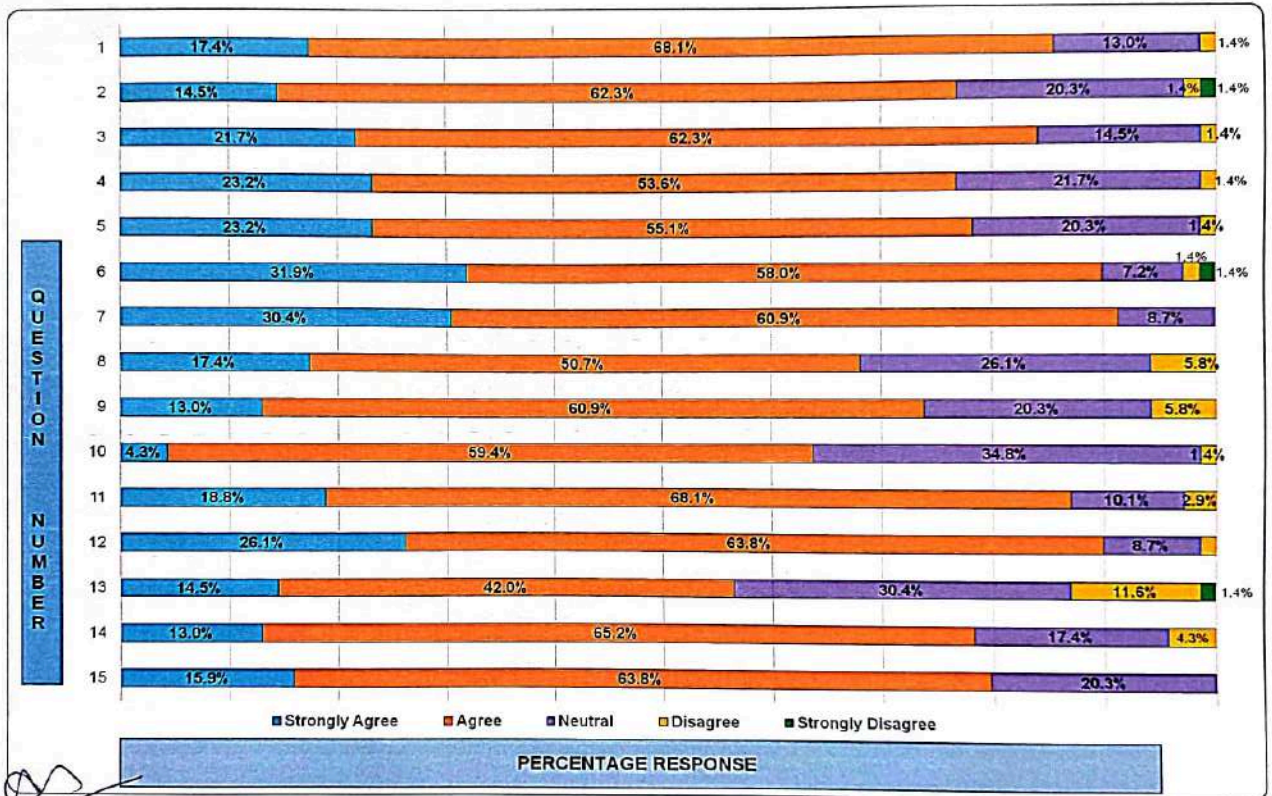

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Figure 1: Percentage responses for each of the questions from B. Ed. first year students of Batch 2023-25



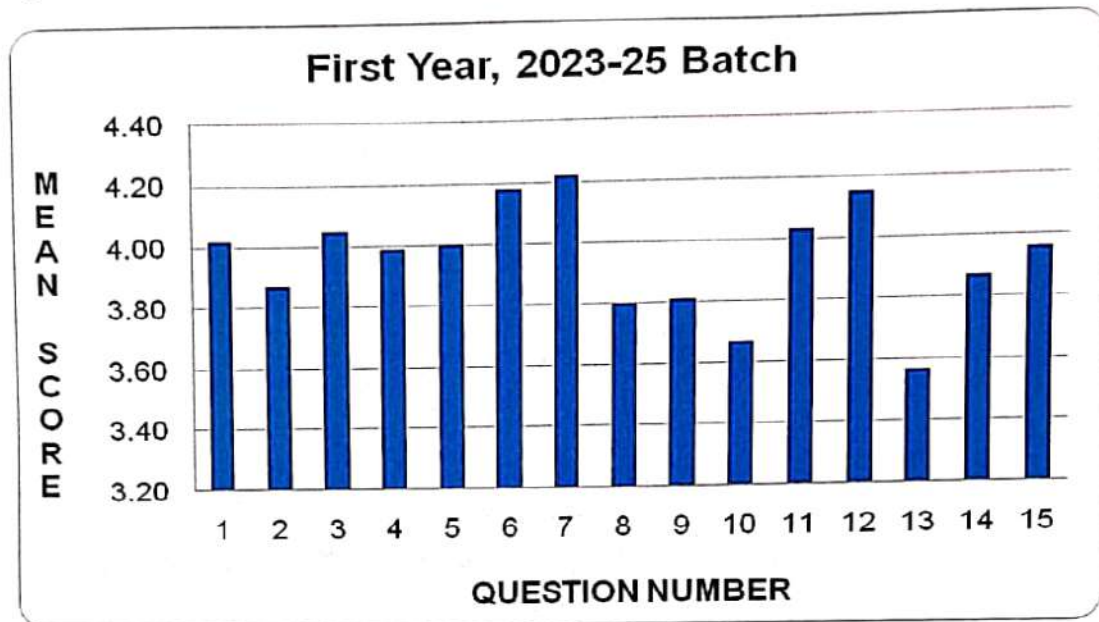
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

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A mean score for each of the questions was calculated by considering the following scores: Strongly Agree (5), Agree (4), Neutral (3), Disagree (2) Strongly Disagree (1) and depicted for each of the questions in the Figure-2

The mean score for all questions ranges from 3.57 to 4.22 representing question no 13 and 7 respectively. The lower mean score (3.57) is obtained for question no 13, indicating students' opinion that duration mentioned in the curriculum to complete the content is not sufficient. The highest mean score of 4.22 is obtained for question no 7. It indicates that students opined that the curriculum is designed to adopt innovative techniques / strategies of teaching such as group discussions, seminar presentations and learners' participation. The lower mean score is further given to qus no 10 (mean score 3.67). It indicates that students have less agreement with the statement 'Cross-cutting contemporary issues are addressed through Add-on Courses'.


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Some of the suggestion/ Remark as mentioned by first year students are:

- Session on "Mental Health Awareness" can be organised to help educators support their students' well-being.
- Hands-on experience with Special children should be included in the curriculum.

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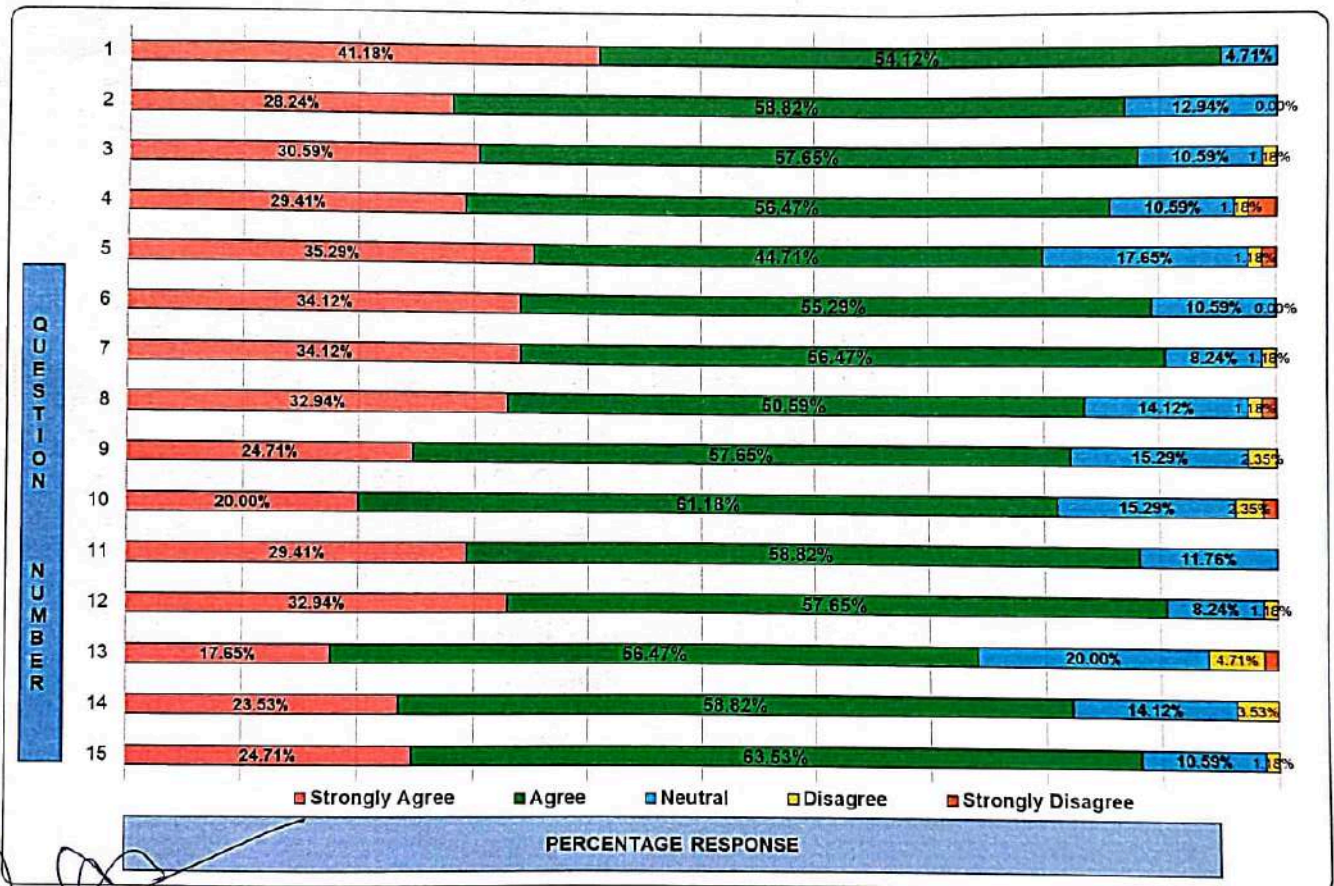

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Figure 3: Percentage responses for each of the questions from B. Ed. second year students of Batch 2022-24





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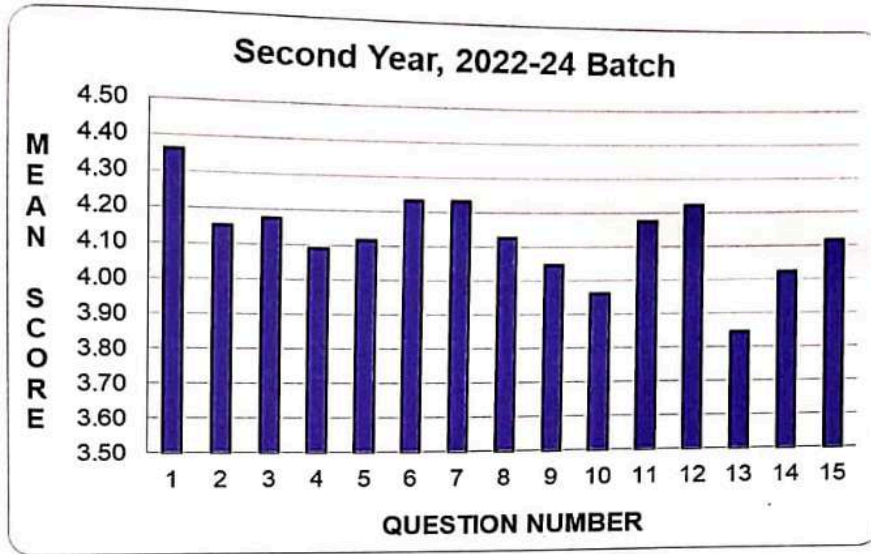

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
Figure 4: Mean score for each of the questions

The other question with comparatively lower scores is qus no 10. It shows less agreement of students with the aspect 'Cross-cutting contemporary issues are addressed through Add-on Courses'.
