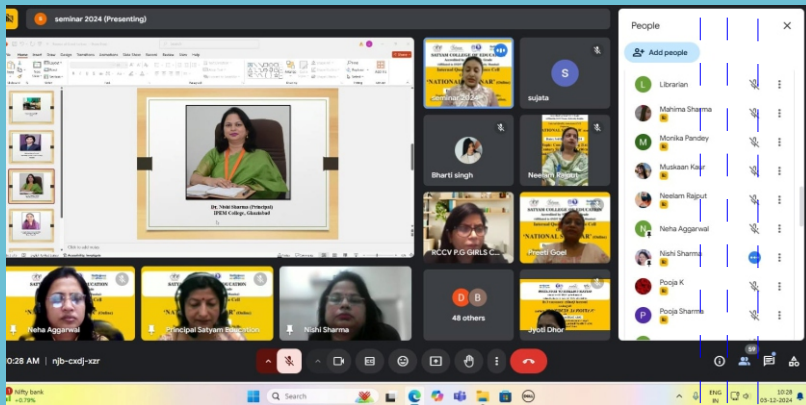

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National Seminar on "Conceptualizing 21st Century Skills (4Cs: Critical Thinking, Creativity, Collaboration, and Communication)"

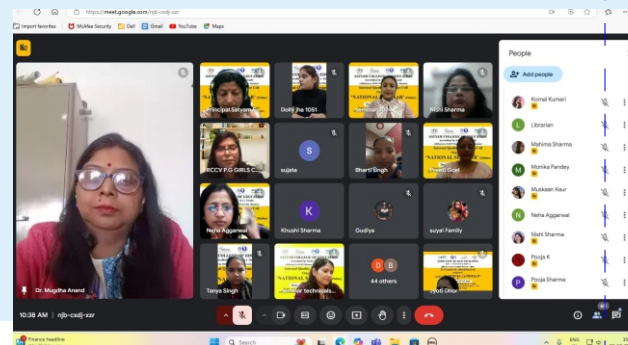
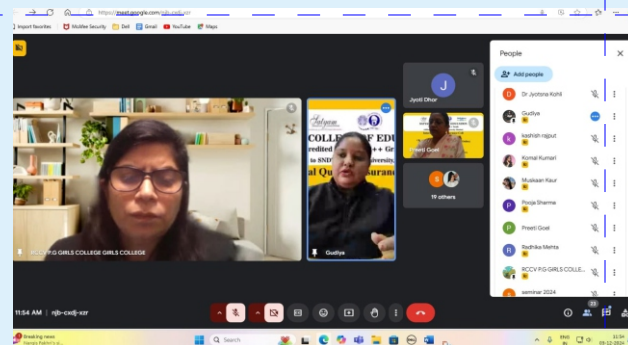
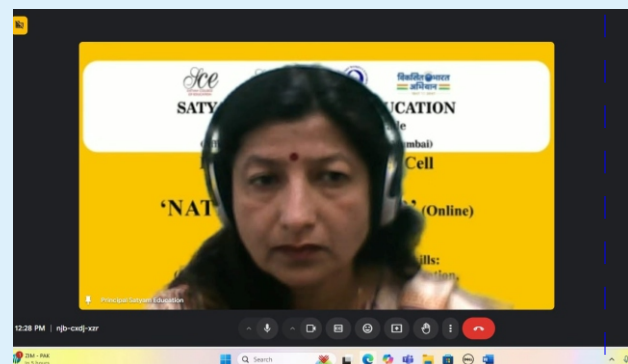

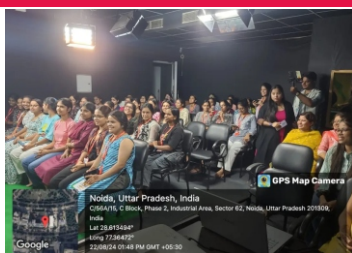
Zee TV Media Programme Debate

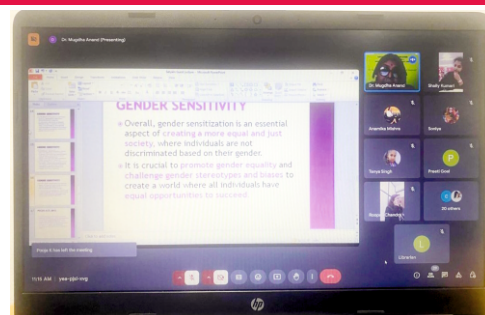


Professional Ethics

Equitable and Inclusive Education



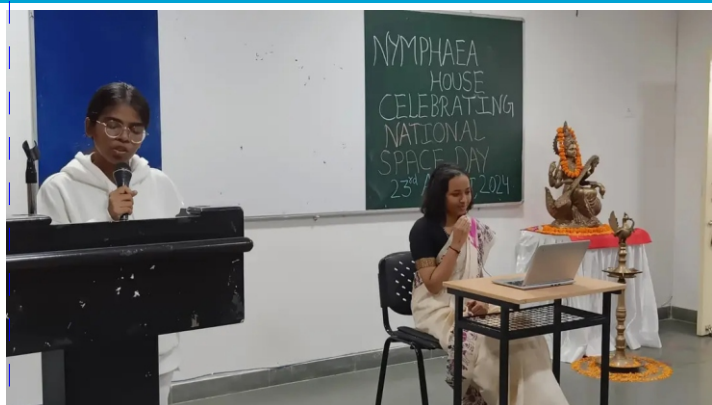

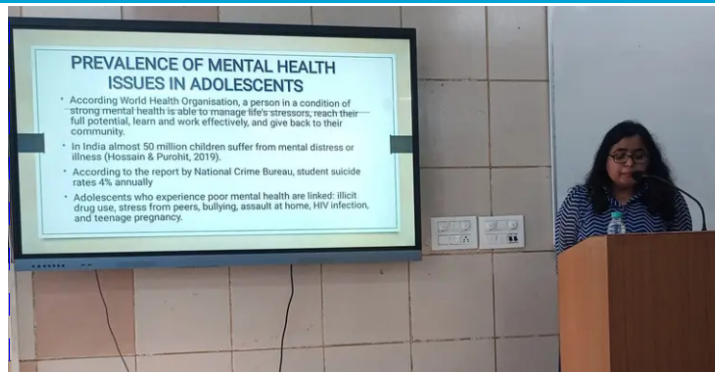
Medical Camp
