FRESHERS



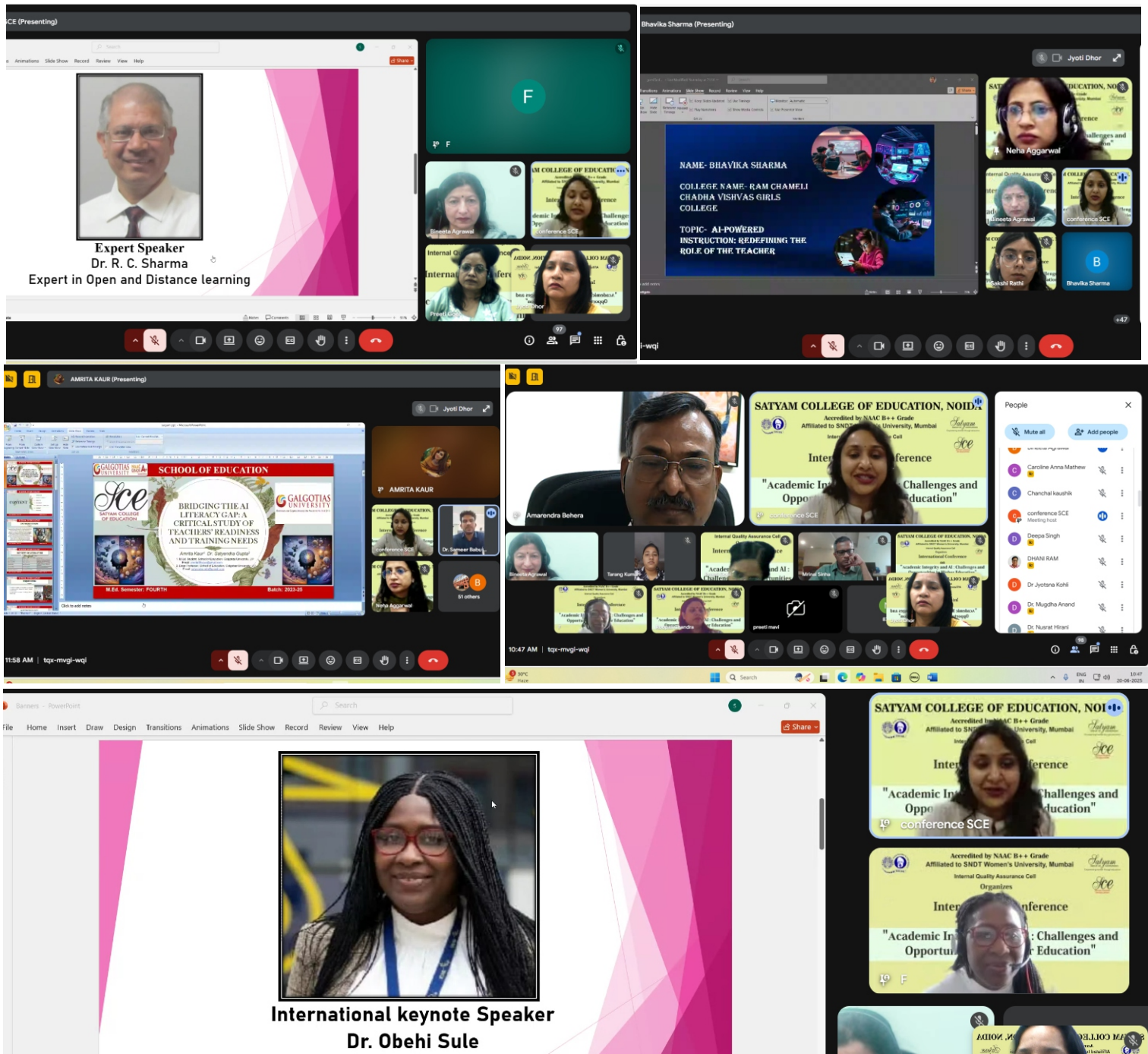

The complex, recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, showcases a blend of architectural styles and cultural influences from various ruling dynasties, including the Tughlaqs, Alauddin Khalji, and even the British, who contributed to its development over time.

Students had the opportunity to explore several historically significant structures within the complex. The Alai Darwaza, with its Indo-Islamic design, stands as a beautifully crafted gateway. The Alai Minar, an unfinished tower envisioned by Alauddin Khalji, gives insight into his ambitious architectural plans. The Iron Pillar, a marvel of ancient Indian metallurgy, continues to astonish visitors with its rust-resistant composition, standing tall for centuries.

Foundation, New Delhi at Amity International School, Vasundhara, Ghaziabad on 15th February 2025.



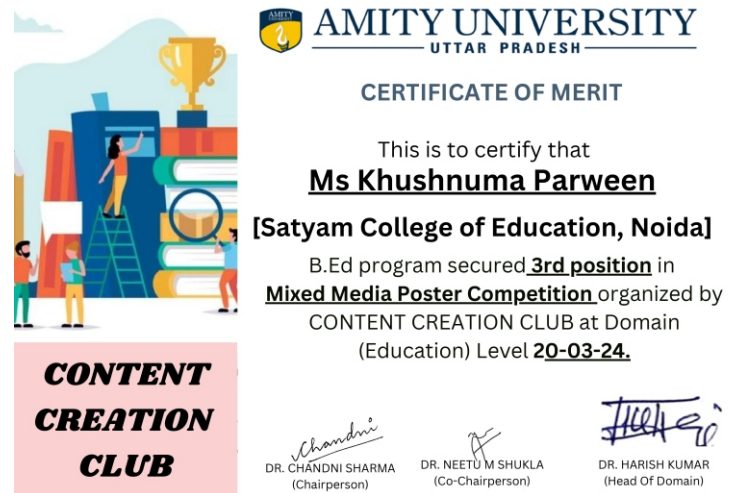
Visit to World Book Fair
