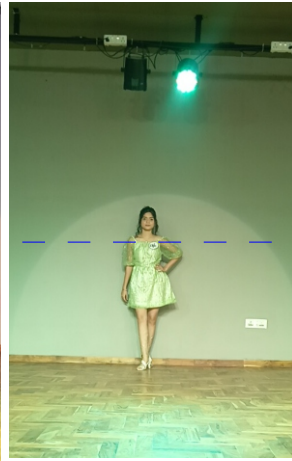


### Freshers' Party

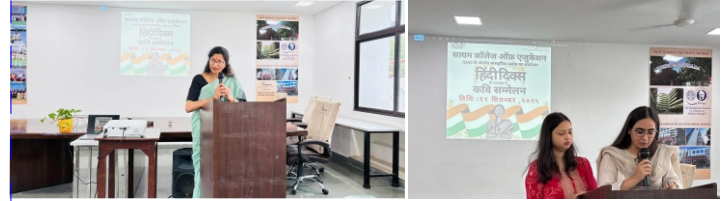
### Poster Making Competition (B.A., B.Com. & B.Sc.)
